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Know your Hazards

- 1; Field Day and the club picnic are held in the great outdoors. Always respect the weather. If you see a storm approaching warn others – if you see lightning cast off your antenna lines and/or ground them. Use individual station grounds back at each tent or the pavilion.
- 2; When erecting tall masts wear a hard hat. Follow safety precautions about lifting the mast beyond the tipping point or the sections may come apart. Wear gloves whenever driving stakes into the ground.
- 3; While working in the field, wear long pants and substantial shoes or boots – no sneakers or sandals. Watch out for gopher holes in the field. Use bug repellent with “Deet” to repel ticks – spray your shoes, socks, and your pants.
- 4; Keep all gasoline cans several feet away from running generators. Stop the generator before refueling – have a second person stand by with a fire extinguisher in case you have a spill.
- 5; Run power cables and extension cords parallel to the walkways and off to the side so they don't trip anyone. ALWAYS plug your extension cord into the GFCI located on the power post or use a portable GFCI at your individual station location.
- 6; The First Aid kit is located in the pavilion – several members are First Aid certified. Wash any cuts or scrapes and apply the appropriate bandage. Report any injuries to the Field Day or Event Chairman.
